



A Draught of a tract of Land in Greenfield township Erie county on the waters of Lake Erie Surveyed the 20th day of October 1801 for Alexander Lowery by virtue of his Actual Settlement, and Resurveyed the 23^d day of September 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the said Alexander Lowery dated the 26th of March 1802. Containing 404 and an half Acres and Allow^{ce} It being the Same tract of Land which was said to have been surveyed on a Warrant dated the 13th day of April 1792 granted to William Smith on condition of Actual Settlement and improvement whereof Default hath Occurred.
