



A Warrant to James Moore Jun<sup>r</sup> for 70<sup>a</sup> of Land in Westfallowfield township Dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1788 appears to have been Regularly Executed in December 1789 under the Direction of Charles Dilworth then Deputy Surveyor. The above draught is a Description of the same. Containing 69<sup>a</sup> 20<sup>p</sup> and the Allowance of Six P Cent. for Roads &c. I have examined the Draughts &c relative to the same & believe they may be depended on.
