



Draught of one hundred and sixty one acres and fifty one perches of land with six per cent for roads situate part in Greenwood & part in Fermanagh townships in Mifflin county which is part of a tract of land surveyed 22<sup>nd</sup> April 1765 in pursuance of a warrant to Samuel Hunter dated 20<sup>th</sup> July 1755 said to contain 354½ acres situate then in Cumberland county. From official papers remaining in my office the above part appears to have been resurvey'd and struck off 9<sup>th</sup> April 1789 for the use of William Thompson agreeably to a conveyance made to him. Calculated & drftd 5<sup>th</sup> November 1811.
