



Whereas there was surveyed to Agness Wilson (deceased) three hundred & ten acres & 122 perches & allow<sup>e</sup> in Millford tow<sup>n</sup> ~~town~~ Cumberland now Mifflin County on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1768 in pursuance of her order of survey dated April 2<sup>d</sup> 1767- William Wilson one of the heirs of the said Agness hath this 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1792 with the consent of his Co-heirs caused his part to be seperately surveyed for the purpose of obtaining a patent &c<sup>a</sup>
