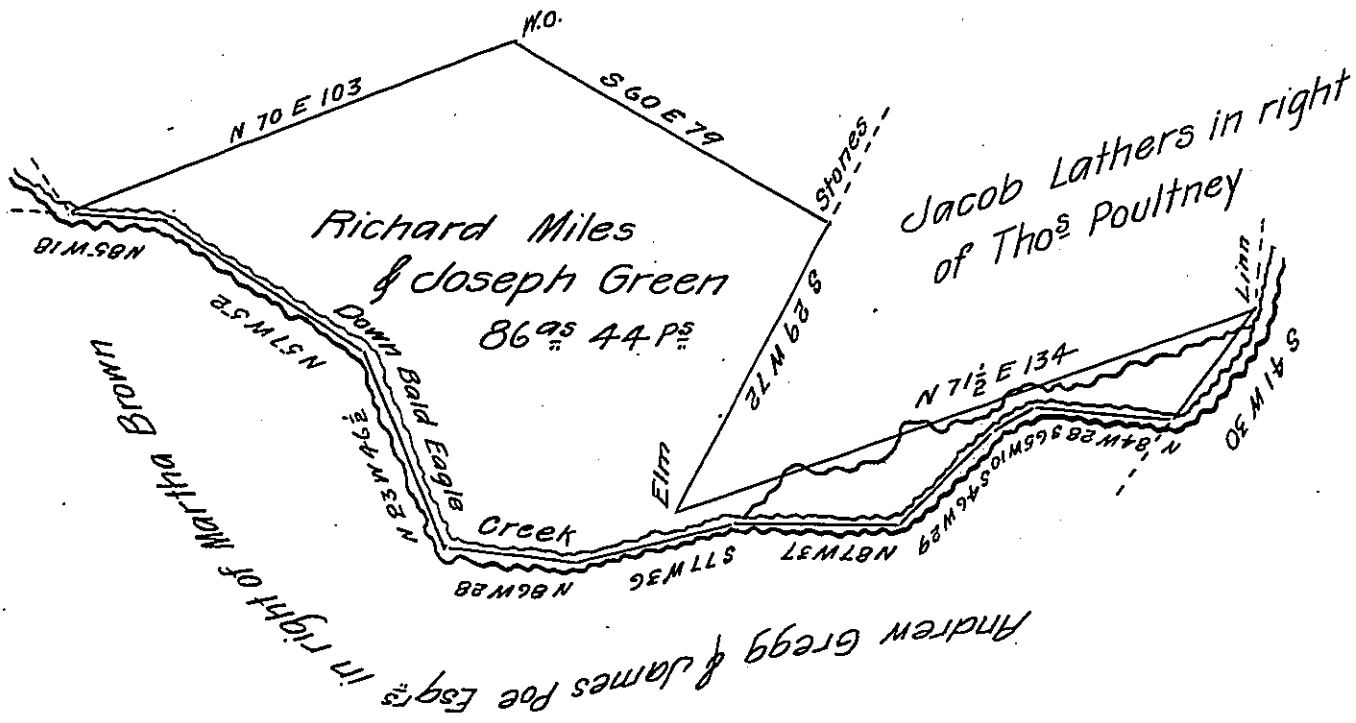


Jacob Lathers in right of John Keble

Centre County Containing ~~eighty six~~ eighty six acres forty four perches and allowance of six per cent &c. being part of a tract of land surveyed to Thomas Smith on Application No 300 dated the 3rd day of April 1769 including fifteen acres and one hundred and twenty perches of Vacant land. Resurveyed the 8th day of December 1820 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to Richard Miles & Joseph Green dated the 27th day of June A. D. 1820.
