



Situate in Shirley Township Huntingdon County No 1. Containing one hundred acres and one hundred and thirty seven perches and allowance Surveyed March 22nd 1810 on Warrant granted to Hugh Logan dated March 21st 1787. No 2. Containing two hundred and thirty one acres and one hundred and thirty two perches and allowance. Surveyed September 30th 1811 on a Warrant granted Simon Logan dated June 19th 1811.

Note, There is about ten acres cleared on the above tract, a good Cabbin and a family residing therein
