



Situated on Two Mile Run a Branch of Beaver River that empties into Beaver on the West Side of the same 2 Miles above Fort McIntosh in District No. 1 being the 5th Survey Westward of the Division Line of said District and No. 2 in the 5th Parallel South of the 3d 4 Miles Square from the Northern Boundary of that Tract of Country appropriated by law for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depreciation &c and Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 Pursuant to Instructions from John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania
