



Situated on the Waters of Monongahela River in Rostrevor Township Westmoreland County and Surveyed the 12th Day of August 1786 In Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to said Matthew McKimney for Three Hundred Acres of Land "including an Improvement on the Waters of Monongahela River Adjoining Lands of Walter & James Hall on the South Robert Craighthead on the West Stephen Hall on the — & others known by the Name of Grassy Fort in the County of Westmoreland" &c Dated the Sixth Day of February 1786 Which Land being before Appropriated this Land is Returned to Satisfy said Warrant, for Alexander McClean Esq: Deputy to John Lukens Esquire John Wells Surveyor General
