



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in <sup>Washington</sup> ~~Montgomery~~ Township in the County of Franklin. Containing twenty nine acres and twenty perches and allowance proportional to Six p Cent for roads &c<sup>o</sup> which was surveyed Nov: 22<sup>nd</sup> 1776 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Mentzer bearing date the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1776 and returned into the Surveyor Generals office; but which Survey Interfer'd with the adjoining Tract of William Baird. and now January 1<sup>st</sup> 1796 examined and corrected following the lines of said Bairds Survey. in doing which some vacant land falls into Mentzers Survey which a little augments the quantity
