In pursuance of two Warrants, one for two hundred ^{& nine} acres, dated 13th January 1801, making together 309^a 154^p; the 100^a being represented by dotted lines, & both included in one Draft at the instance of the present owner Peter Beeche Jr. who wishes both to be included in one patent. Calculated & Returned at said Beeche's request this 18th day of Jan^y. 1825
