



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Lebanon Township in the County of Lancaster containing one Hundred and Seventy one Acres and an half and the Allowance of Six acres & Cent for Roads and Highways. Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April 1745 by Thomas Cookson Esquire late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for Thomas M<sup>rs</sup> McCormick in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date at Philadelphia the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1744.
