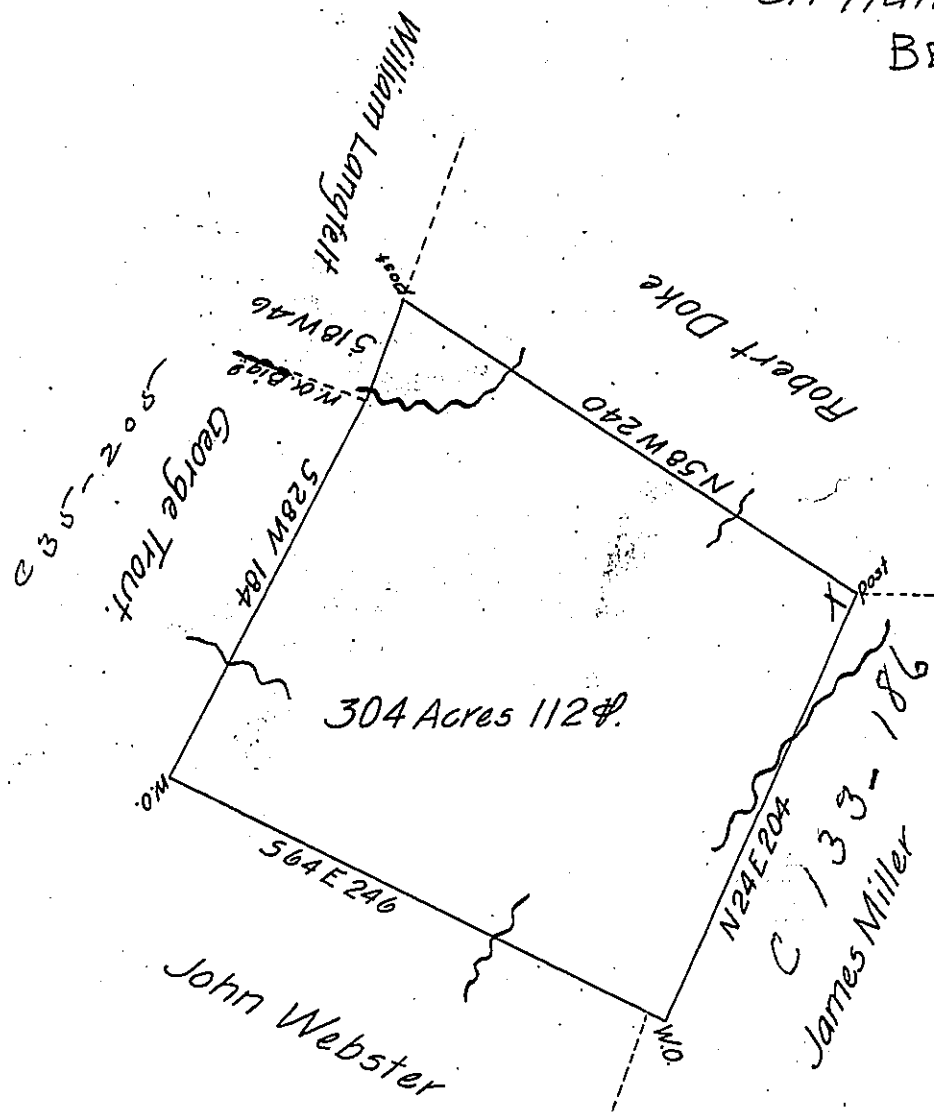


ON HANOVER TWP. BEAVER see 180

The above is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed July 11th 1809 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Marshall, dated September 21st 1785 Situate in Hanover Township Beaver County on the waters of Kings Creek adjoining lands of William Langfelt, George Trout and others Containing 304 Acres & 112 perches and allowance of six per cent.
