Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 7th of the 4th mo. 1767 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Samuel Moser bearing date the 22nd of Jan^y. 1767. Surveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 26th day of May 1792. And now, after having been Carefully examined Corrected and Calculated it is at the request of the present owner, Adam Fry, returned for Confirmation the 10th day of August A.D. 1809.
