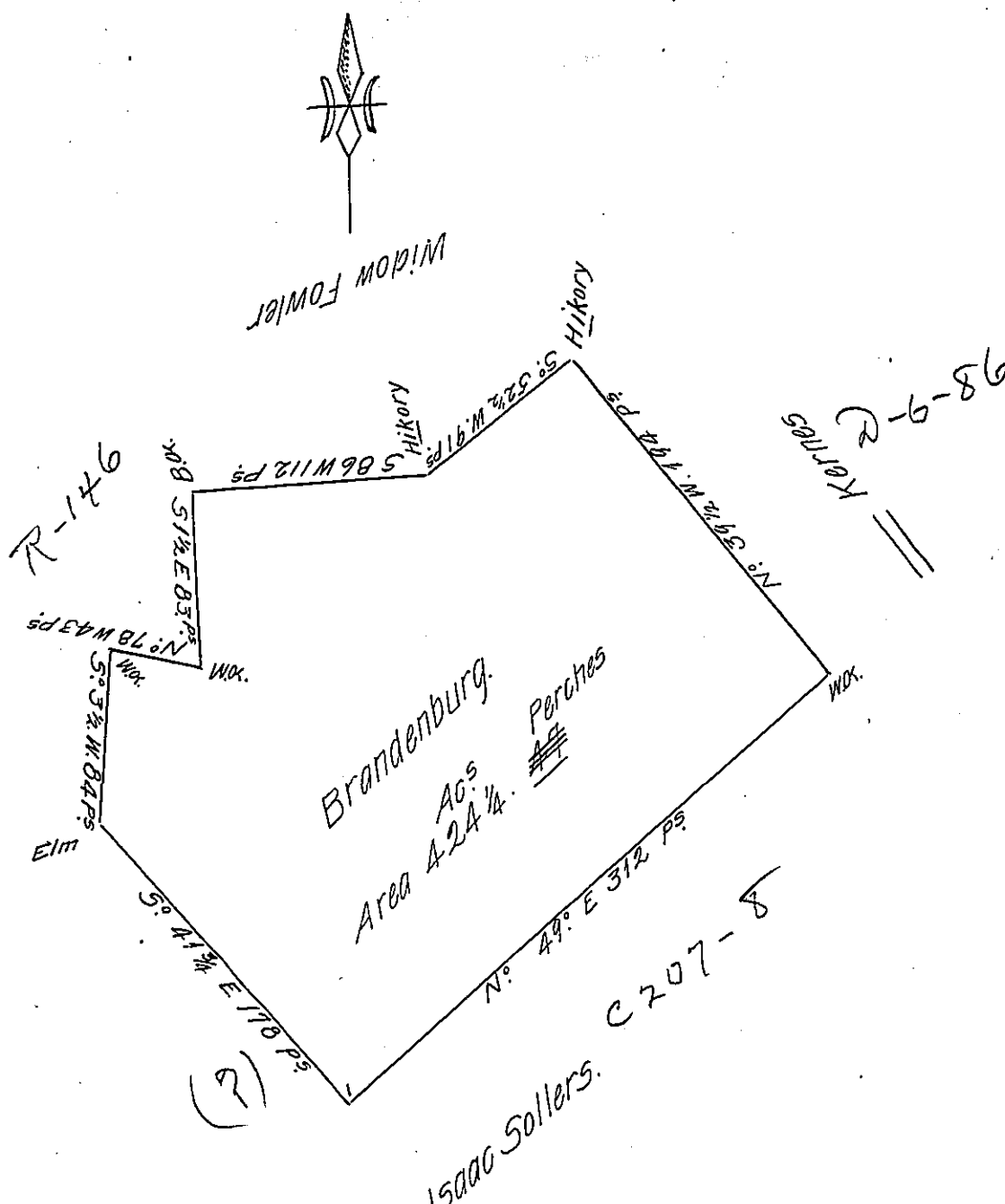

A Draught of a Tract of Land lying on the Waters of Shirtee Creek Called Brandenburg, containing Four hundred and Twenty four Acres and ~~and~~ Forty seven Perches, surveyed August 5th 1785 for Jacob Malch Ass^{es} of Nathaniel Stokes on a Virga Certificate in these Words.

"We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby certify that Nath. Stokes is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land Yohogania County on the Waters of Chartiers Creek to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord, 1774 also a Right in Preemption to One Thousand Acres adjoining thereto."

Given under our Hands at Cox's Fort the 18th Feb^y 1780 in the fourth year of ye Common
