



Situate in Washington (formerly Warrington) Township, York County, and Containing as above set forth 101<sup>a</sup> 100<sup>ps</sup> and allowance of land. Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson, late D.S. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1762 in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1751 granted to Abraham Miley for fifty Acres. Resurveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1802. And now, after having been carefully examined Corrected & Calculated it is at the request of the present owners, Frederick Flegler And Abraham Grove, Returned for confirmation the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August, Anno Domini 1809.
