



Situate in Fawn Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 24.9 & 123 Perches and the Usual Allowance & c. Being part of a larger Tract of Land, Originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. in Pursuance of a Warrant for 100.9 Granted to George Mitchell bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1773. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1802 and a small piece of Vacancy added. In Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property bearing date the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1802. granted John McCoy at whose request the same is now returned for Confirmation the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June Anno Domini 1810.
