



Situate on Pine Creek in Mifflin Township. Resurvey'd for William Porter the 29th day of May 1810 in pursuance of a note from the Surveyor General by Virtue of a Preemption Warrant granted to John McElwane dated the 1st day of September 1785 for three hundred and fourteen acres & One hundred and twenty one perches of Land, the above Tract being part of the same, and Convey'd by the 5^d John McElwane to the 5^d William Porter containing one hundred and thirty five acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches and allowance of Six pr. Cent. for Roads &c.
