



In pursuance of a Warrant Dated 15<sup>th</sup> June last, Granted to Robert Morris & Mathew Tyson for Resurveying a Tract of Land Situate on the Swamp Creek in Milford Township Bucks County, late the Estate of Reinier Tyson dec<sup>d</sup>. In obedience to the Requisition of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup>. Surv<sup>r</sup>. Gen<sup>l</sup> the Said tract was accordingly Resurveyed & divided, the 5<sup>d</sup> Robert Morris's part thereof described by the black lines containing 645 Acres & 65 perches Strict Measure. Resurvey'd & divided the 26 & 27 July 1785.
