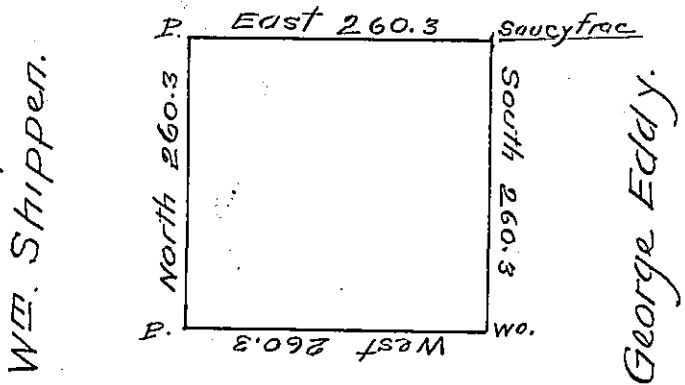

Wells called Asturia - containing 400 acres with the usual allowance of 6 per Cent for
