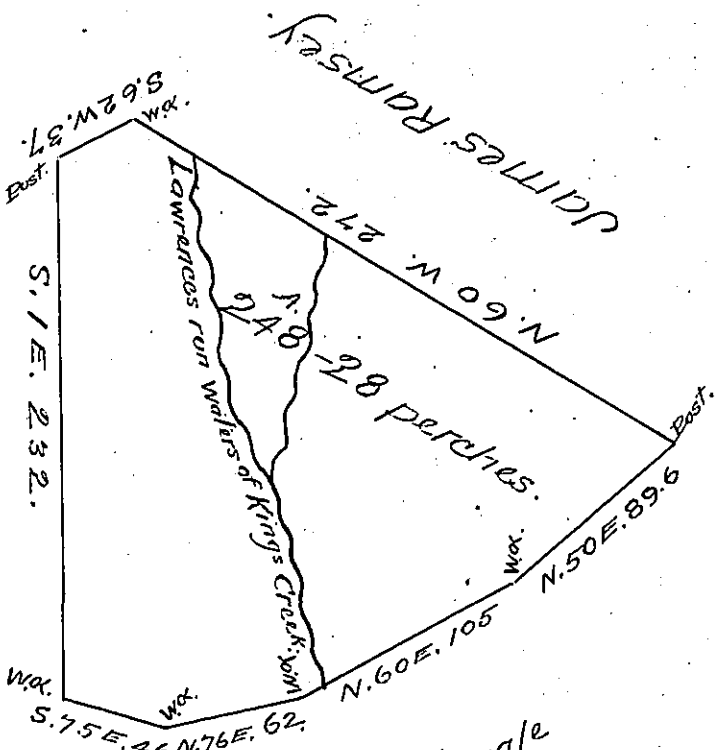

By Virtue of a Warrant Granted to James Miller dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1796, the above described tract of Land Containing Two hundred forty eight acres & Twenty eight perches together with Six & Cent allowance for Roads, situate on the Waters of Kings Creek in Hanover Township Washington County, was Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1796, by Thomas Stakeley Esquire Deputy Surveyor and now Examined and Certified to be Correct this 3<sup>d</sup> day of February 1804.
