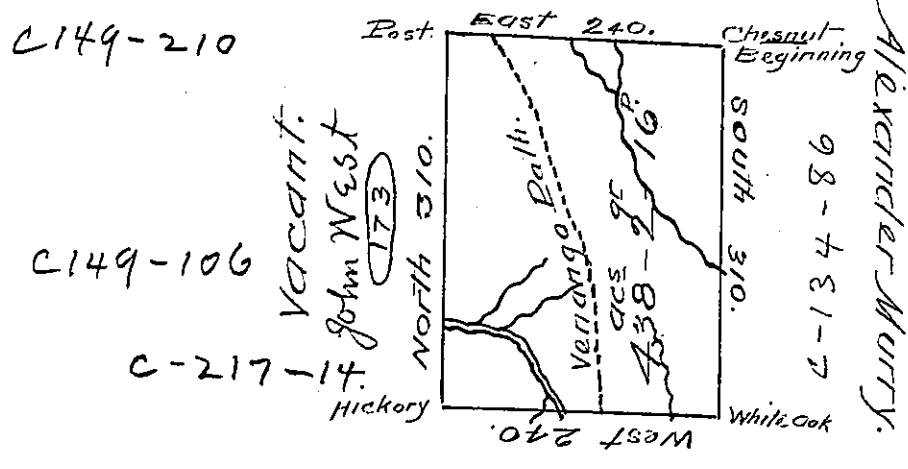

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 5th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Miller for 400 acres of Land Dated the Tenth day of February 1794 adjoining Alexander Murry to the westward including the head Branches of a Stream which Empties into the Alleghany River North and West of the River Ohio Called Plum Bottom-Containing four Hundred thirty eight and one half acres and sixteen poles together with the usual allowance of Six Percent for Roads.
