A Draught of a tract of Land Surveyed the 21st day of September 1802 for David McCoy by virtue of his Warrant for 300 Acres of Land dated the 24th day of June 1788 - Situate on the Waters of Raccoon Creek in Washington County, including an improvement adjoining Land of Major Kirkpatrick and others called Mount Mico containing four hundred and five acres fifty two - perches together with six per cent allowance for Roads &c.
