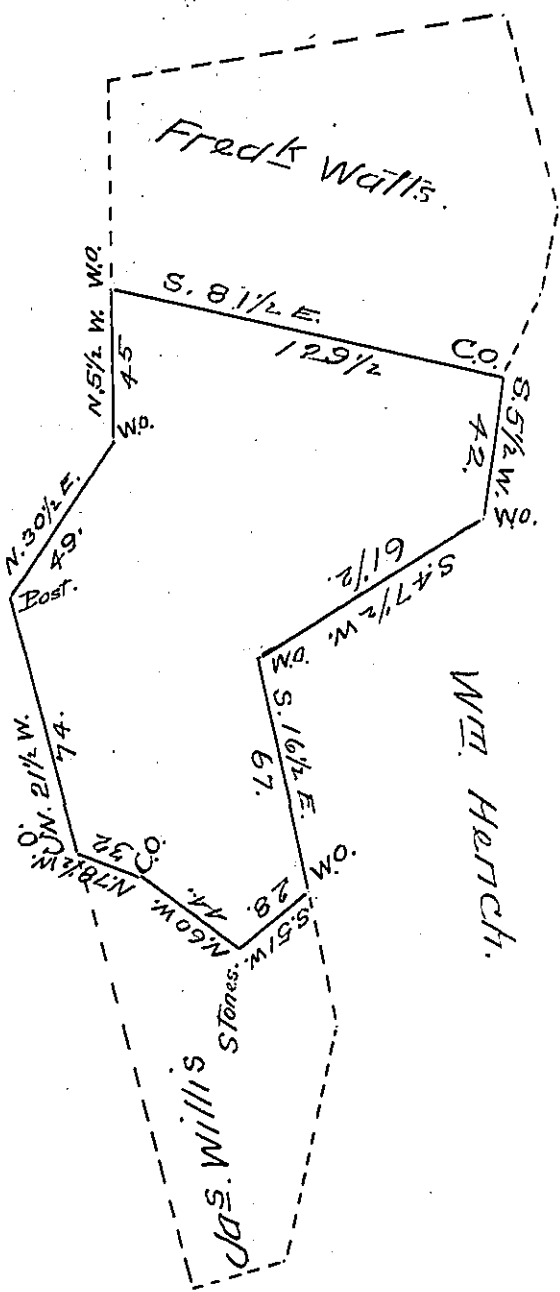


Dunbar Iron Company.
