



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim Township, in the County of Franklin (formerly Cumberland) Containing one hundred and twenty one acres, 17 Perches, & the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Survey d. 2^d February 1787 (by the late Matt^w Henderson D.S.) under the Inspection of the High-Sheriff of Cumberland County, in Execution of a writ of Possession issuing out of the Supreme Court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bearing date 7th October 1786 - commanding the said Sheriff to put James McLene (Plaintiff) in Possession of one hundred & thirty acres of Land, by him recovered by verdict & Judgment, obtained in the said Court against a certain William Eaker (Defend^t)

Resurvey^d 9th September 1800 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Daniel McLene bearing date 14th September 1750. The small dotted strip at the South East end was taken into the quantity Laid off for James McLene but it's found to be included in one of his other surveys. Resurvey^d with the consent & approbation of all Parties.
