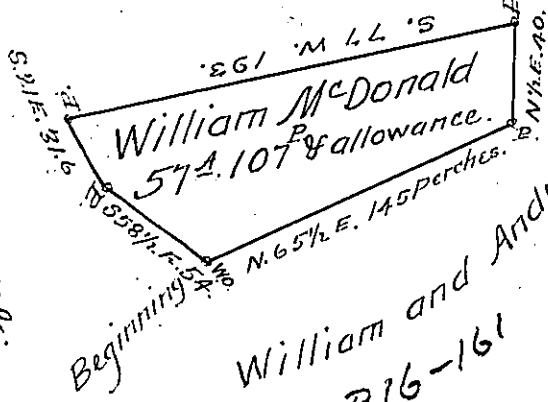

The above Draught represents a survey made January 20th 1836 for William McDonald of Hopewell Township on unimproved land, being part of a survey * * * * * situate in Hopewell Township on the waters of Logstown Run; adjoining lands with James McKee on the north; Andrew McDonald on the East and South, and Thomas McKee on the west. Containing fifty seven acres, one hundred and seven perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
