



Situate on the head waters of a large run emptying into Laurel Hill Creek about a mile below Jones Mill in Milford Township now Somerset County and surveyed the 28th January 1796 by Alexander McClean Esq^r late D.S. as appears by his official Draft remaining in my office in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George King dated the 27th June 1794.
