



A Draught of a Tract of Land Called — situate on both sides of Hoopiny Creek about four Miles and a half from the mouth including an Ash Tree marked with four Notches & two Blazes Standing on the bank of the Creek in the County of Northumberland Containing three hundred and forty four Acres besides the usual allowance of six Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 6th Day of October 1774 For James Mease In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15th day of June 1774 by
