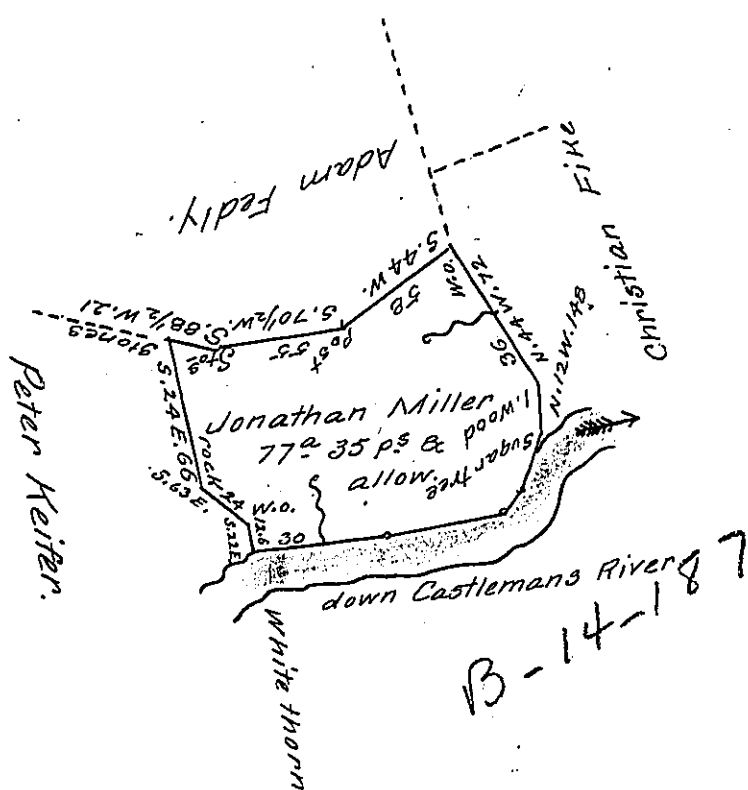


The courses and distances
