



A Draught of a Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks marked in a general Plan of Said Town Number Two Hundred and Twenty four. Containing in Breadth North and South on Clement Street Sixty feet, and in length East and West Two Hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Richard Street, Eastward by Clement Street, Northward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Twenty Two and Westward by a Twenty feet Alley, Returned into the Secretarys Office the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1776 for Matthias Moyer
