



Jephthah Morton

The above is a correct Resurvey of a Tract of Land originally surveyed for him by Wm McClay then Deputy on the 18th of April 1772 on an Order N^o 3721 dated the 7th of August 1769 to Jephthah Morton and was then thought to contain 186 Ac^s & all^s and by virtue of the Order of the Board of Property it has been Resurveyed and found to contain 203 Ac^s 96 perches exclusive of the part south of the dotted line which contains 16 acres and is claimed by a Warrant to Wm Gray dated November 18th 1788 which was in my hand some months before the application of Jephthah Morton to have his survey enlarged but at the pressing instance of Morton is taken in as above and is situated in Buffalo township Northnd County Done this first day of November 1804
