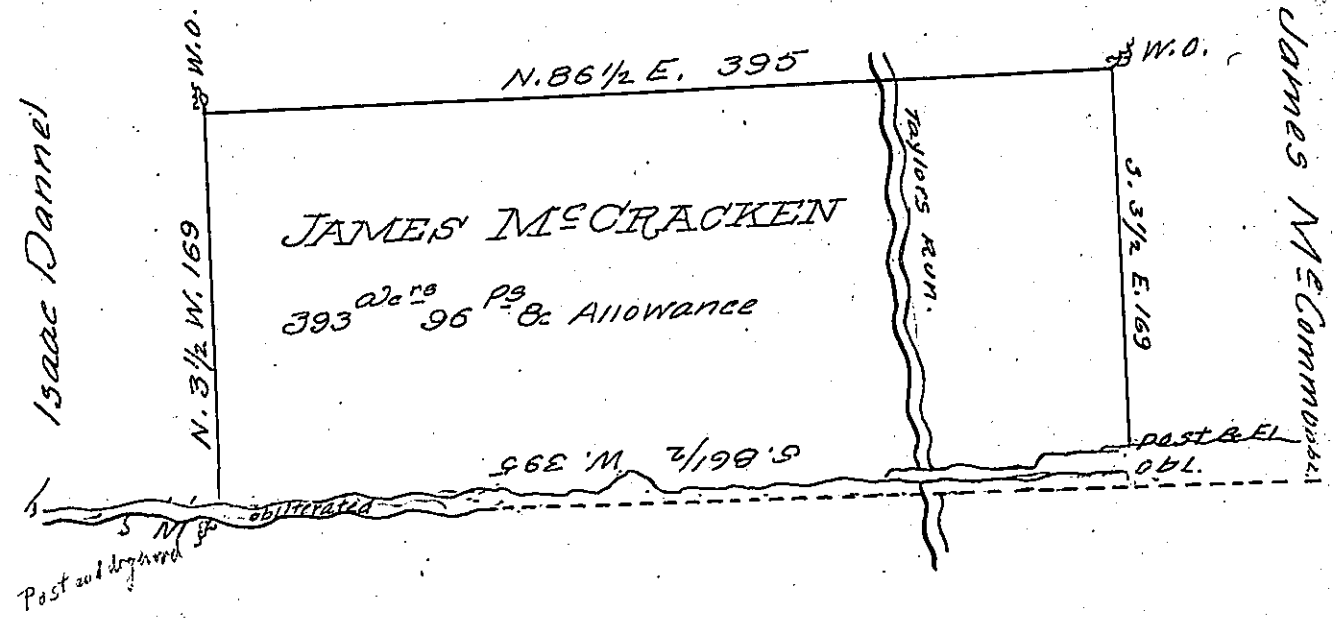

Note: The dotted line was conditional, between Jn^o Gaily and Ja^o McCracken. When
 the land was originally Run out by Finly-Stewart in laying Gaily's warrant has
 intruded over the conditional line nine perches and 4 tenths, which by 395 (as meas-
 ured by Finly and by myself a second time in order to be correct) takes off Mc-
 Crackens tract obl. and 33 perches and adds no more than three acres to
 Gaily's Stewart has committed a great Blunder, his East & West line being
 no more than 384, and his North and South lines must also be proportion-
 ally less than the true measurement.
