



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres of Land Baring date the 17th Day of March 1813 was surveyed on the 20th day of April 1813 for Jacob Mattocks the above Discribed tract of Land Containing four Hundred and Eighteen acres Seventy Eight perches and allowance of Six ps Cent for Roads &c. Situate in the head waters of Big sandy Creek in fallowfield township Crawford County and at the time of Surveying the Jacob Mattocks was Living on the same with his family and a house barn and other buildings a Baring orchard and upwards of one hundred acres Cleared fenced and in a good state of Cultivation
