



The above described Tract of thirty seven acres and ~~sixty seven~~ ^{one hundred & fifty seven} perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is part of a larger Tract of 870 55 ps & also situate in Washington Township Franklin County (formerly Antrim Township Cumberland County) which was surveyed the 8th day of October 1743, by Thos Cookson Esqr then Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for John Leeper in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Wm Patrick bearing date the 24th of August 1743, as appears by a Copy of said Warrant and Survey, signed George Stevenson one of the Executors of Thos Cookson decd remaining in my office Resurveyed and divided off for George Cook Junr the 22nd of May 1822 including a small vacancy for which no other claim appeared.
