



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on or about the line dividing Green and Southampton Townships in the County of Franklin, purporting to contain four hundred and thirty four acres eleven perches and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c which appears on a general Draught or class of Mountain Surveys, with the name of "John Mitchell," entered on the Draft and purporting to have been Surveyed on the 4th of August 1794, And which answers to the location of the Warrant granted to John Mitchell bearing date the 24th March 1794, which I have carefully copied from said Draught remaining in the D. Surveyors Office of Franklin County.
