



The above is a Draught of a Survey made sept. 17th. 1833 for Alexander— Containing two hundred & thirty seven acres and 79 perches Strict measure within the black lines, situate in Hanover Township Washington County, on the waters of Kings Creek, being part of an original Survey made March 17th 1786 on a Virginia Certificate granted to George McCaslin Decd for 400 acres. The Dotted lines represent the balance of the Tract which is owned & occupied by the heirs of said George—as above named.
