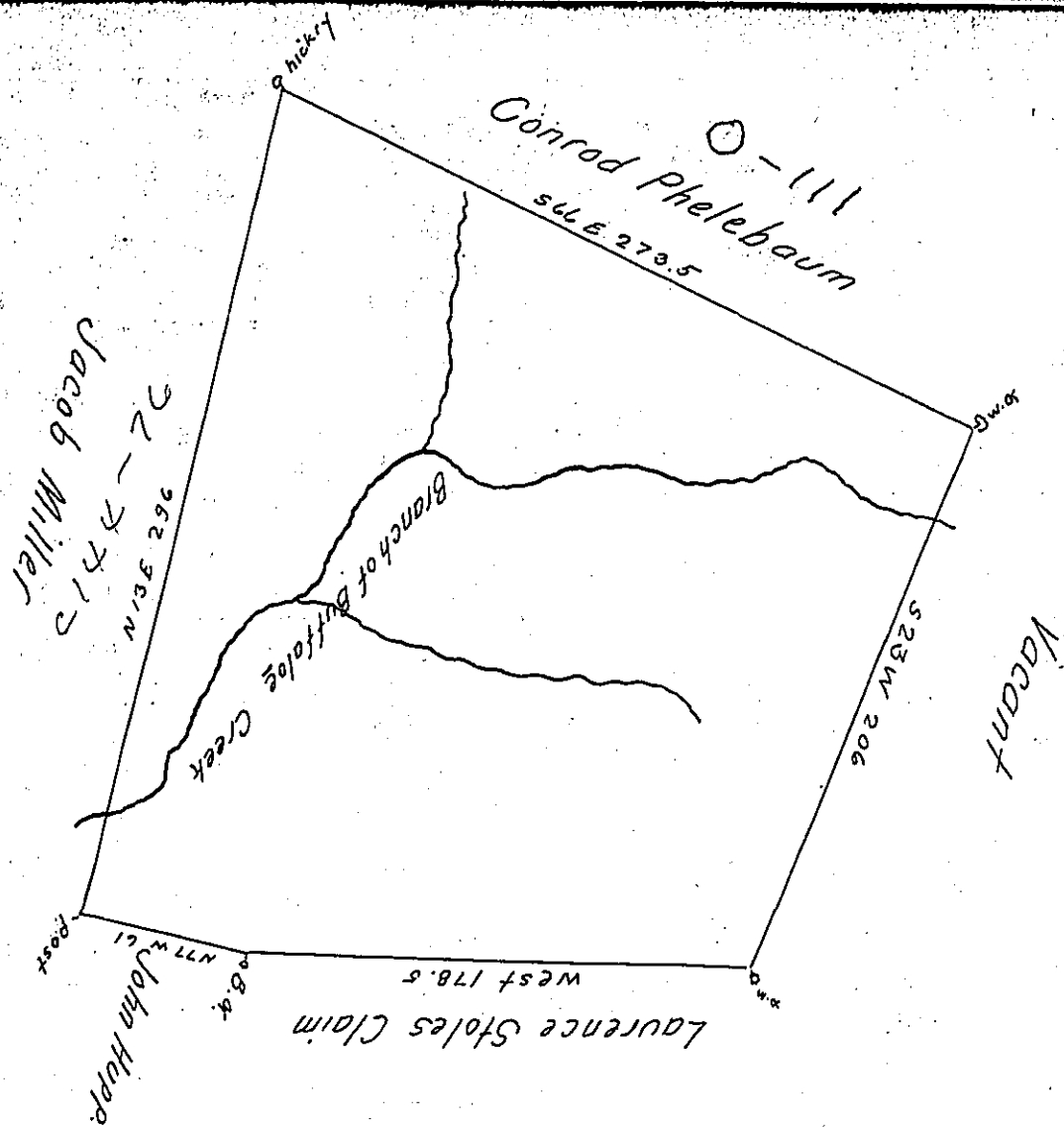


Ret'd 23rd Feby. 1786

We the Commissioners for Adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Francis Miller is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the waters of Buffalo Creek to Include his settlement made in the year 1774. Also A Right in preemption One Thousand Acres Adjoining thereto
