Originally Survey'd January 16<sup>th</sup> 1737 unto Jacob Miller in pursua- nce of a Warrant bearing date January 12<sup>th</sup> 1737. per Samuel Lightfoot then Deputy Surveyor. The above Resurvey'd & divid- ed for Daniel Kemp. October 15<sup>th</sup> 1818.
