I have understood that the above land was Surveyed and returned from Butler County, perhaps upon a Copy of this same Warrent, with the exception of that part of the N. W. Corner. Marked off by dotted lines. Containing nineteen acres and 55 perches. the object now is to embrace that corner in this Warrent, as it appears to be otherwise unappropriated. I see nothing improper in so doing. I understand that many years ago an old Man of the Name of Foster. Claimed this small piece, raised a by in^g of a Cabbin about four rounds high, but never resided on it in consequence of his claim, it got on the unseated list, and was sold for taxes, but still is not occupied nor I believe Claimed by anyone but Mrs. Elliot, for her Children. upon this Warrant. From the Books and documents in my possession it does not appear to be appropriated to the use of any other, than the Heirs of W^m Elliot.
