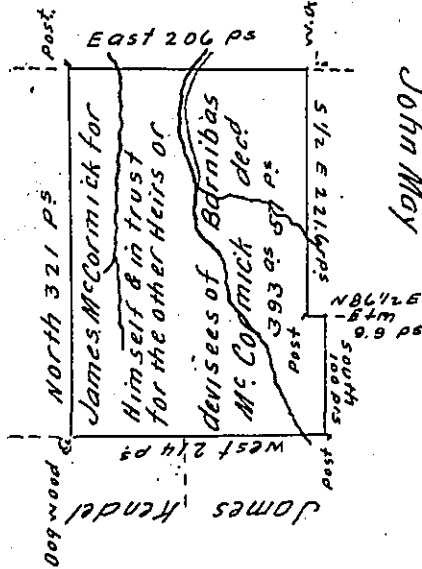

In Pursuance of a warrant for 90 acres dated the second day of March A.D. 1818 granted to James McCormick for himself and in trust for the other Heirs or Devisees of Barnibas McCormick dec'd was surveyed on the twenty second day of December A.D. 1818. - The above described tract of land containing 393 acres 57 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Fairfield Township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, James McCormick & other Heirs was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of Seventy acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided ~~as~~ ~~above stated~~ between said James McCormick & other Heirs
