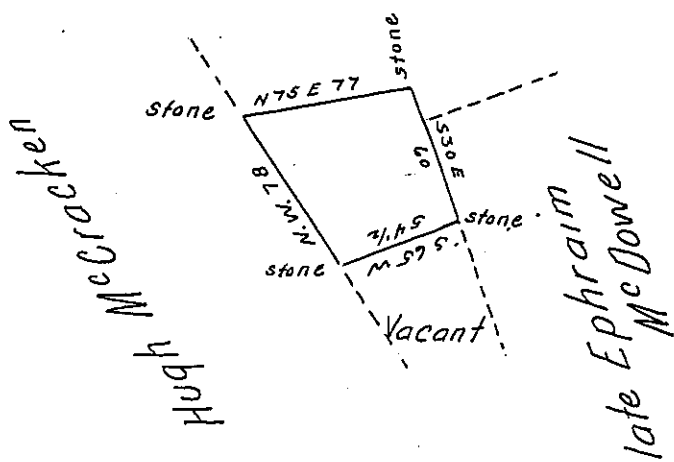


James Muchlehenny
