In Pursuance of a Warrant for 332^{acs} dated the fifth day of July A.D. 1814 Was surveyed the fifth day of May A.D. 1815- for Ebenezer Magoffen the above discribed tract of Land containing three Hundred Sixty three Acres, sixty two perches and Allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate on the East side and adjoining French Creek about four Miles above Meadvill- in Mead Township Crawford County Pa and at the Time of Surveying the same George Fershd was Living on the same A Tenant under said Ebenezer Magoffen. and there appeared to be upwards of thirty acres of the Land Cleared, fenced and in a good state of cultivation.
