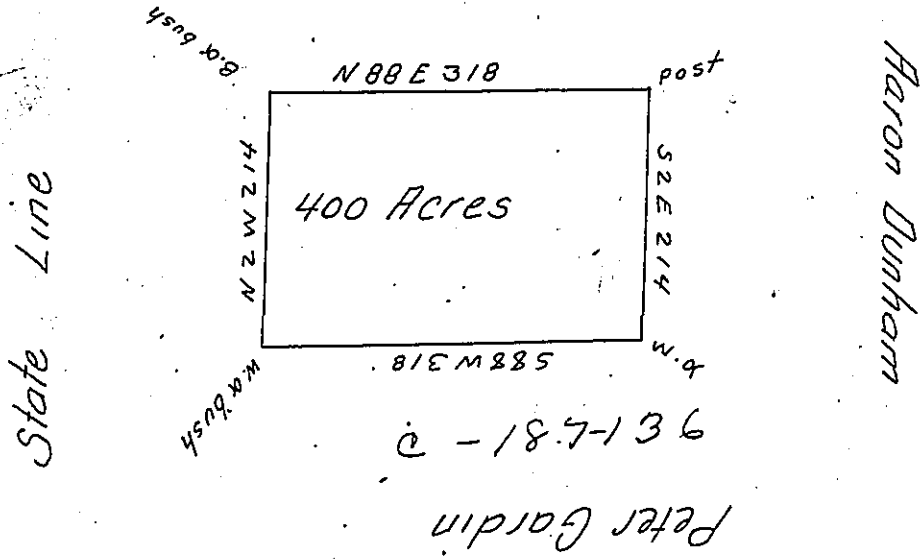


CV 48-15<sup>v</sup>
