S. on the 6th of the 8th M^o 1794. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 27th day of April 1787. being part of a larger tract of ~~786⁰⁵ 97^{PS}~~^{1289⁰⁵ 69^{PS}} and allowance. Resurveyed and Divided off from the 5^d larger tract of land on the - day of - A. D. 1802. And now at the request of John Sechrist the present owner the same has been calculated examined &c. and found to be correct the 1st day of May 1821.
