



Situate in White Deer Hole Valley on Black Run in Washington Township (formerly North & now) Lycoming County bounded as above described, surveyed to Henry McCartney on the 13th day of April 1844 by virtue of his Warrant for 50 acres bearing date the 24 of January 1794. Containing forty three and one-half acres with allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
