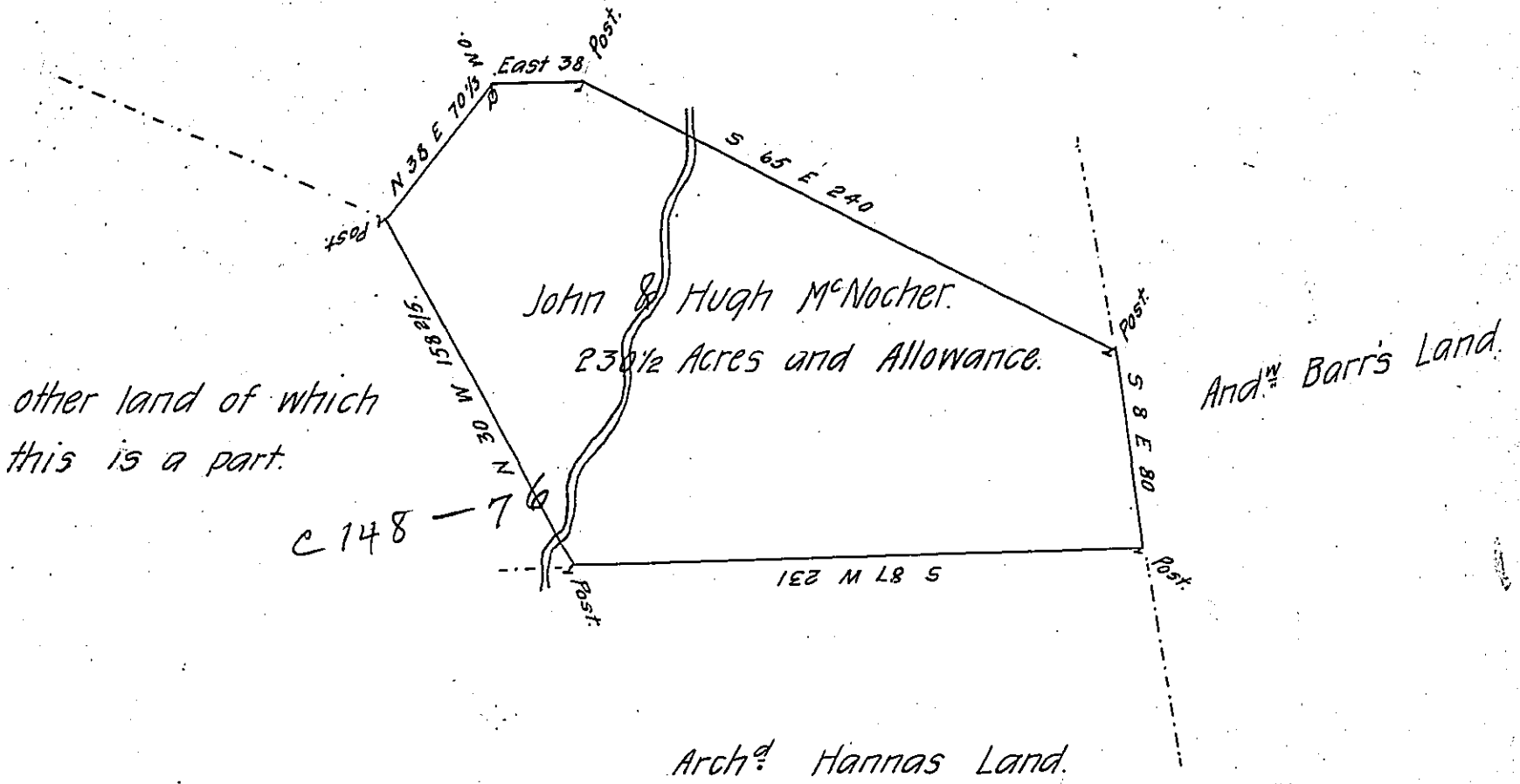

Whereas John & Hugh McNocher in pursuance of their Warrant dated Feb^y 1st 1787 did on the 12th Day of June 1787 obtain a Survey and a Return thereof to the Surveyor Gen^{ls} Office of a Tract of Land Situate in Fairfield Township in the County of Westmorel^d and being now desirous to Patent a part thereof have requested a division of the same Tract to be made therefore in compliance with their request I have on the 13th Day of Nov^r 1801 Surveyd the above described piece of land containing two hundred and thirty Acres and a half acre with an Allowance of Six P Cent part of the Tract above mentioned
