Numbered 14, in the County of Northumberland, containing three hundred and Eleven Acres and fifty perches besides the usual allowance of Six ~~of~~ Cent for Roads &th Surveyed the 29th day of July 1775, for Samuel Meridith in pursuance of a Warrant Numbered 15, dated the 28th day of December 1774.
