



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 1775 was Survey'd to James McClenaghan, by W<sup>m</sup> M<sup>c</sup>Clay then Deputy, the above described Tract of thirty Acres & 31 perches and Allowance included within the black lines, and Situated as above, on the 8<sup>th</sup> of September 1775. Situated adjoining on both sides his other land in Buffalo Township, North<sup>bd</sup> County and was Resurveyed on the 10<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>br</sup> 1803, by the old lines, and Certified this 6<sup>th</sup> of August 1805.
