



Situate in Alegary Township, in the County of Huntingdon, on the South East Side of the West Branch of Sisquahanna - & about one Mile from Said Branch Containing 400 Four Hundred acres & Fifty five perches, and the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1802. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of March 1785, and of an order of the Board of property dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1802.
