Sir, on the 2nd of June last, a Warrant for 290a. of improved land in Jenner Township, Somerset County, was issued to Samuel Murphy, of this Township, with the return of Survey made in pursuance of that warrant, a note of Caveat was made in my favor for Sixteen and a half acres. Situate on the North west Side of the creek. The difficulty between Mr. Murphy and myself is Settled and I wish the caveat to be considered as inoperative and void; and the Patent to issue to Murphy on his future application for it, just as though no caveat had been entered by me.
