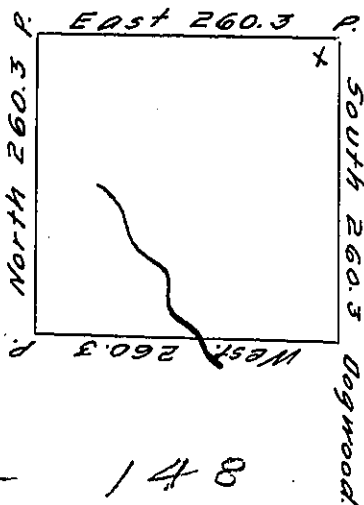

The above is the draught of a Survey made December 6<sup>th</sup> 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas L Moore, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to James Moore, called Cairoan, containing four hundred Acres with the usual allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent 8<sup>th</sup> c<sup>9</sup>
